



**Christmas Cat Cuddleathon 2020
Covid-19 Health and Safety Protocol for Attendees**

1. No more than 6 members of the public to be allowed at the Home for the event.
2. This means unfortunately we can only take in 6 attendees who will be cat cuddling and fundraising and cannot accommodate additional spectators.
3. Children over 8 are welcome to join us, but they must be supervised by an adult if under 18. Due to limited spaces, both must take up one of the 6 spaces and fundraise £100.
4. All fundraisers will be required to wear a face mask covering their mouth and nose for the duration of their visit and use alcohol hand sanitizer upon arrival.
5. Fundraisers will be shown a designated toilet to be used on the day.
6. All fundraisers will be required to use the track and trace app upon arrival.
7. All fundraisers will be required to sign a form upon arrival to confirm that they have not:
 - Experienced any symptoms of Covid-19 recently.
 - Been within close proximity to another person who has experienced symptoms of Covid-19. A list of symptoms can be found via the NHS website here <https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/symptoms/>
8. Fundraisers will be asked to socially distance from each other and BCDH staff on the day and not to touch surfaces other than in their cat pod.
9. Cat pods will be thoroughly cleaned prior to fundraisers' arrival. Attendees will be required to sit in the outside sections of the pods to cat cuddle so we can distance you effectively.
10. We will be unable to accommodate briefings in the meeting room as usual, a short briefing will take place in reception or outside depending upon weather so that we can distance attendees properly.
